



Decorating a Tea-light Candle Holder

Requirements

Acetate Red cardstock
Candle Scissors or trimmer
Cotton wool or sponge Double sided tape
Drinking Glass Surgical alcohol
Paper punch (*All around the page* by Martha Stewart)
Spectrum Noir alcohol pens in bright reds

Instructions

Step 1 - Colouring the acetate:

• Colour the plain acetate sheet with bright red pens.

Step 2 - Marbling with alcohol:

- Dab the alcohol soaked cotton wool onto coloured acetate.
- A marbling effect will develop. Wait for it to dry.

Step 3 - Punching a pattern onto cardstock:

Using the decorative paper punch, punch out the desired pattern onto the card stock, so
that the candle light may shine through. Make sure the images line up for an evenly
punched result.

Step 4 - Decorate the candle holder:

- Attach the acetate sheet to the punched cardstock with double sided tape.
- Measure the glass height and trim the paper and acetate to the required height.
- Stick edges together with double sided tape to fit over glass
- Light a tea candle inside the glass and enjoy a beautiful soft light effect.
