



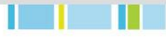

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

Mosaic Street Scene

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The Clay Club



Requirements

- Wooden base board
- Ceramic tile inserts comprising of shutters, doors, flower boxes, window boxes, tiny flowers
- Wood glue
- Grout
- Tile cutters.
- Mosaic tiles in two tones for each building
- Black mosaic tiles for the road at the bottom

Instructions

Step 1

Take the wooden base board and draw lines down for each building.

Step 2

Place the ceramic inserts (shutters, roofs and doors) as shown in the picture in the correct places and glue them down.

Step 3

Cut the mosaic tiles for the buildings in half and glue them down in a staggered pattern so that they look like the bricks of a building. Make sure all the spaces are filled with tiles.

Step 4

Leave the project to dry overnight to ensure that the glue is completely dry before grouting.

Grout as follows:

- Mix grout with water, adding a little at a time until the consistency of your grout is similar to that of peanut butter.
- Apply the grout over the complete mosaic area, ensuring that the grout fills up the gaps between the tiles.
- Scrape off the excess grout with a rubber squeegee or similar tool and sprinkle some dry grout powder over the mosaic. This will absorb the moisture in the grout mixture and speed up the drying process.
- Leave the grout powder on your design for about 3 minutes then wipe clean with a paper towel.



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
