



Painting the drawers on our table

Requirements

Wooden table

- Thinners
- Cloths
- Paint brush, Paint scrapper & Vaseline
- Tjhoko paint in the colours of your choice

Instructions

The Tjhoko colour palette was designed in such a way that all the colours complement each other. So you can pick and choose the colours that you like and they will always match. For this project we used Coral Stone, Vinia Stone and Comfort's Blue.

Step 1:

Clean the surface being painted by wiping it with a cloth dipped in some Thinners (NOT TURPS). This will remove any oily residues from furniture polish or furniture oil. Wait a few minutes for the Thinners to evaporate and start painting.

Step 2:

Paint the surface of the drawers and allow it to dry, approximately 20 minutes. The order in which you use the colours, doesn't matter.

Step 3:

Randomly apply a generous amount of Vaseline on the painted surface, using your fingers. Now paint a contrasting colour, over the Vaseline and make sure you cover the entire surface. This coat of paint won't stick to the areas that have Vaseline. Wait for the paint to dry, use a paint scraper and scrape the paint from the Vaseline coated areas.

Step 4:

Repeat step 3 until all the drawers are complete.
